### Mission Statement:

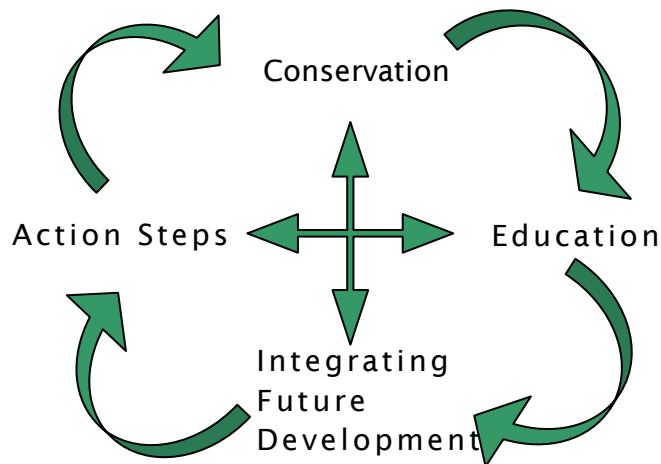
